

**Wineglass Bay,** 200 kilometres from Hobart, is one of the top ten beaches by the US magazine Outside in 1999. The tour of East Coast and Freycinet National Park contains unforgettable scenic spots, including Cape Tourville, Honeymoon Bay, Coles Bay. Take a short, fairly steep climb to the saddle between Mt Amos and Mt Mayson, from where, a side track leads to a new lookout, with one of Tasmania's most celebrated views over the beautiful white sands of Wineglass Bay. Half way a visit to Kate Farm can be organized at your own expense to taste and buy unique ice cream and jams.


